DUMPING – Policy & Process: Non-Members

- 1. Any member may report an alleged non-member dumper to the Bowls Director.
- 2. If the Bowls Director confirms that the allegation has substance, he/she will speak to the non-member dumper about the problem.
- 3. The confirmed non-member dumper will be advised to seek help from a suitable person to see if the problem can be fixed via improved technique or by using a "Bowlers Arm".
- 4. The confirmed non-member dumper will be advised by the Bowls Director that he/she will be unable to play on Belmont's greens until the dumping problem has been fixed.
- 5. The club of the confirmed non-member dumper will be notified by the Belmont Bowls Director.
- 6. If the confirmed non-member dumper thinks he/she has solved the dumping problem, he/she can request the Belmont Bowls Director to lift the ban on playing on Belmont's greens.
- 7. If the dumper considers he/she has been unfairly treated during the above process, he/she may appeal to the Belmont Bowls Committee.

NOTE: This "Dumping – Policy & Process: Non-Members" will also apply to Belmont members who do not play Pennant Bowls for Belmont.
